

of the vibrato width, whereas the periodicity indicates the rough speed.




Multiphonic fingerings

Last as long as the black line they are attached to.

Air pressure

The more white in a box, the higher the air
pressure required to cause the given pitches to speak.



Slap tongue

Notated with plus sign.

Flutter tongue

Indicated with 3 tremolo lines

Colour trills

All trill indications are colour trills and below the staff.
If there is no attached fingering suggestion,
the previous one applies. The periodicity of the oscillations
in a given line indicate the rough speed.
